So making CDS is a double infusion process and the recipe is this:

- 1. Put 300 milliliters of distilled water into the hermetic jar.
- 2. Place the shot glass into the jar.
- 3. Use the 10 ml syringe to measure 5 milliliters of Part A (22.4% sodium chlorite solution) and put it into the shot glass.
- 4. Use the 10 ml syringe to measure 5 milliliters of Part B (5% hydrochloric acid solution) and put it into the shot glass.
- 5. Close the lid down on the hermetic jar and latch it.
- 6. Put the jar away in a closet or little used cabinet for 24 hours.
- 7. 24 hours later, remove the jar from the cabinet, open the jar, remove the shot glass and close and latch the jar. Be careful to avoid the fumes.
- 8. Dump the contents of the shot glass into the garbage or store it in a plastic bottle for use as disinfectant.
- 9. Use the 10 ml syringe to measure 5 milliliters of Part A (22.4% sodium chlorite solution) and put it into the shot glass.
- 10. Use the 10 ml syringe to measure 5 milliliters of Part B (5% hydrochloric acid solution) and put it into the shot glass.
- 11. Re-open the hermetic jar and place the shot glass in it and close the lid and latch it.
- 12. Put the jar away for another 24 hours.
